We continue also to partner with other service providers for the benefit of the members. On offer now are water tanks, insurance products, mobile phones and soon to come are vehicle tyres and home appliances. You are welcome to our office for more information on these products.

Otherwise we continue to listen to your opinions and we assure you of our focus to transform Shelloyees SACCO to be your first stop financial solution partner.



HERE'S A QUICK GUIDE!


1 Using google chrome as your browser search for; https://shelloyeessacco.co.ke. On the website, click on the link to access the portal.



On the portal use your member number as the username and your existing password to login to the portal. In case you have forgotten your password click on sign up
